

TMWA'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND STAFF SEEKS YOUR COMMENTS

In order to better serve our customers, TMWA has many ways for you to provide comment. TMWA's Board of Directors and staff want to hear from you and know what is on your mind regarding your water service. We invite you to attend any of our public meetings, as there is public comment at the beginning and end of each meeting. Here is how you can reach out and be heard, and be part of the process:

- **BOARD MEETINGS** – TMWA's Board of Directors typically meets on the third Wednesday of each month at 10 a.m. at the Sparks City Council Chambers, located at 745 Fourth St. in Sparks. Agendas are posted online at least five days in advance. View the full meeting schedule, agendas or past meeting minutes here: www.tmwa.com/meeting.
- **STANDING ADVISORY COMMITTEE** – TMWA's Standing Advisory Committee (SAC) is an oversight group made up of individuals representing all TMWA customer categories. SAC reviews rate proposals, budgets and other items as requested by our Board of Directors. SAC meetings are held on the first Tuesday of the month at 3 p.m., at TMWA's main office, located at 1355 Capital Blvd. in Reno. All meetings are open to the public and are posted in the "Meeting Center" section at www.tmwa.com/meeting.
- **ONLINE AT www.tmwa.com** – If you are unable to attend a public meeting but still wish to comment on a topic, you can do so by submitting your comment online at least one full week before the date of any board meeting.
