TMWA'S PUBLIC INPUT PROCESS

As a customer, can I be part of TMWA's decision-making process?

Truckee Meadows Water Authority (TMWA) was created in June 2001 through a Joint Powers Legislation of the state of Nevada and is subject to the Open Meeting Law. As a publicly-owned agency and the largest water purveyor in the Truckee Meadows, we are here for you, and we value what you have to say.

In order to better serve our customers, we have many ways that customers can provide comment to our Board of Directors and staff. We want to hear from you and know what is on your mind. We invite you to attend any of our public meetings; there is a public comment section at the beginning and end of each meeting. Here is how you can reach out and be heard, and be part of the process:

- **Board of Directors**

Our Board of Directors consists of seven members representing the Reno City Council (3 seats), Sparks City Council (2 seats), Washoe County (1 seat) and one member at large (1 seat). The At Large member is required to be an elected official from one of the owner agencies. The remaining six members can be elected officials or appointed by elected officials. The TMWA Board of Directors meets at the Sparks City Council Chambers, located at 745 Fourth St. in Sparks. Board meetings are typically scheduled for the third Wednesday of each month. - **Standing Advisory Committee**

The Standing Advisory Committee (SAC) is an oversight committee made up of individuals representing all customer classes. Members complete an application process and are selected by the Board of Directors. The SAC reviews all rate proposals, budgets and other items as requested by TMWA's Board. You are welcome to attend any of its monthly meetings, held at TMWA Main Office at 1355 Capital Blvd., in Reno. For a list of all meeting times, go to www.tmwa.com/meetings.
