TO DISCUSS POSSIBLE CONVERSION OF FLAT-RATE BILLED
WATER SERVICES TO METERED BILLING

Truckee Meadows Water Authority (“TMWA”) will hold a public open house on Tuesday, March 10, 2015 from 3 to 6 p.m. to receive public input on the possible conversion of flat-rate billing to metered rate billing. The purpose of this open house is to receive public input prior to the TMWA Board of Directors considering whether and when to convert flat-rate billing to metered rate billing, which is anticipated to be discussed as soon as the March 18, 2015 TMWA Board meeting. Conversion of flat-rate billing may affect customers who have Residential Flat-Rate Water Service (RFWS), Small Unit Flat-Rate Service (SUFR), Multiple-Unit Residential Flat-Rate Service (MRFS), Multiple-Unit Residential and Irrigation Service (MRIS), former STMGID Rate Residential Unmetered Service for Residential and Irrigation Service (FRMSGID), and former Washoe County Rate Residential Unmetered Service for Residential (FRMWC) rate tariffs. TMWA is asking for your input concerning conversion from flat-rate billing to metered rate billing, including the timing of such conversion. It is anticipated that any decision on the conversion of flat-rate billing will require subsequent amendments to TMWA’s Water Rates Schedule. Customers are encouraged to attend this meeting and provide comments.
