TMWA HONORED NATIONALLY FOR PRODUCING HIGH QUALITY WATER



TMWA has received the “Directors Award of Recognition” from the Partnership for Safe Water. With this award, TMWA’s Chalk Bluff Water Treatment Plant now ranks among the highest performing facilities of its kind in the country, producing high quality water for our customers.

TMWA’s priority is to continuously strive to improve our water quality. By joining the ranks of the highest performing plants in the country, TMWA’s Chalk Bluff Water Treatment Plant has taken a large step toward achieving this goal. Special recognition goes to Paul Miller, Manager of Water Quality and Operations, as well as the entire water quality and operations team, for their hard work and commitment to excellence. TMWA received the Directors Award for successfully completing a rigorous 18-month Self-Assessment and Peer Review process that was developed by national experts and includes thorough assessment of factors that may limit plant performance. TMWA’s Chalk Bluff plant joins 231 plants that have achieved this distinction—which is only two percent of the approximately 11,500 surface water treatment plants in the United States.

WORKING TO BE A CARBON NEUTRAL BUSINESS:

TMWA GENERATES NEARLY AS MUCH POWER AS IT USES

For the third consecutive year, TMWA has produced nearly as much energy as it consumed through its three run-of-the-river hydroelectric power generation plants, solar energy and an aggressive energy conservation program. This year, despite a lower than average snowpack, the hydroelectric crew at TMWA has once again broken the all-time record for both hydroelectric generation and revenue in a fiscal year. The generation total was 52,056,000 kilowatthours (kwh), breaking last year's record by just 72,000 kwh. This takes diligence by the crew to keep water flowing to the three plants despite multiple equipment repairs and fighting ice build-up at the plant intakes during the winter. A total of \$3.5 million was earned this past fiscal year by selling this power back to NV Energy.
