TO DISCUSS TMWA'S PROPOSAL TO BROADEN PURPOSES FOR WHICH METER  
RETROFIT FEE MAY BE USED**

Truckee Meadows Water Authority ("TMWA") will hold a public workshop on Thursday, November 8 at the location listed above. The purpose of this gathering is to receive input and comments from the public on TMWA's proposal to change Rule 7 to broaden the category of projects that may be paid for with funds collected under the meter retrofit fee, which is a fee imposed on new development. Additionally, the proposal seeks to reduce the fee from \$1,830 to \$1,600. The reason for the proposed change is to allow TMWA to use funds collected under the meter retrofit fee for projects that improve this community's water resource sustainability and drought resiliency. This workshop will give the public an opportunity to provide feedback to TMWA staff before a formal rule change is presented to the TMWA Board of Directors.
