The meeting of the Legislative Subcommittee of the Truckee Meadows Water Authority (TMWA) at TMWA, 1355 Capital Blvd., Reno, Nevada in the Independence Conference Room. Member Brekhus called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m.

6. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE DIRECTION TO STAFF REGARDING THE SCHEDULING
OF MEETINGS OF TMWA'S LEGISLATIVE SUBCOMMITTEE

Discussion followed regarding whether to hold a concurrent meeting of TMWA and Western Regional Water Commission (WRWC) and the best day and time for all parties involved.

Upon motion duly made and seconded, and carried unanimously, the TMWA Subcommittee approved to hold a concurrent TMWA and WRWC Legislative Subcommittee meeting on Fridays at 12pm through the legislative session.

Member Brekhuis moved to reopen agenda item 5.

5. NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF CHAIR AND VICE CHAIR OF THE LEGISLATIVE SUBCOMMITTEE OF THE TRUCKEE MEADOWS WATER AUTHORITY

Member Brekhuis suggested Member Dahir be Chair for TMWA's Legislative Subcommittee as he is the only other member that sits on the WRWC Legislative Subcommittee, which will make it more efficient for both entities when scheduling/cancelling meetings. Consideration for Vice Chair will occur at the next meeting.

Upon motion duly made and seconded, and carried unanimously, the TMWA Subcommittee approved Member Dahir to be Chair of the TMWA Legislative Subcommittee.

7. PRESENTATION OF STATUS REPORT ON LEGISLATION OF INTEREST TO TMWA AND POSSIBLE DIRECTION REGARDING TMWA'S POSITION ON LEGISLATION

Steve Walker, TMWA Lobbyist, referred to the table of bills (Attachment 1) reviewed by the TMWA Board but not yet approved.

Discussion followed regarding the possibility of adding a fiscal impact to AB136, but staff recommended it is not necessary; changing the positions on AB136 and AB138 to oppose; changing the recommendation on SB207 from watch to oppose; and no need to continue watching SCR2.

Upon motion duly made and seconded, and carried unanimously, the TMWA Subcommittee approved staff recommendations on all bills in Attachment 1 except the recommendations to oppose AB 136 and AB 138.

Steve Walker described all bills listed in Attachment 2. Michael Pagni, TMWA General Counsel, described three new bills introduced prior to the meeting: SB217, recommended oppose and seek amendment (revises definition of renewable energy projects); SB221 recommended watch (revises noticing on trespassing); and SB245 recommended oppose (increases the award in tort actions from \$100k to \$250k and adds a new class for gross negligence with a liability maximum of \$1M).

Upon motion duly made and seconded, and carried unanimously, the TMWA Subcommittee approved staff recommendations on all bills except to change the position on SB207 from watch to oppose, to oppose SB 217, and to watch SB 221 and SB 245.

There were no committee comments.
