Discussion followed regarding the possibility of adding a fiscal impact to AB136, but staff recommended it is not necessary; changing the positions on AB136 and AB138 to oppose; changing the recommendation on SB207 from watch to oppose; and no need to continue watching SCR2.

Upon motion duly made and seconded, and carried unanimously, the TMWA Subcommittee approved staff recommendations on all bills in Attachment 1 except the recommendations to oppose AB 136 and AB 138.

Steve Walker described all bills listed in Attachment 2. Michael Pagni, TMWA General Counsel, described three new bills introduced prior to the meeting: SB217, recommended oppose and seek amendment (revises definition of renewable energy projects); SB221 recommended watch (revises noticing on trespassing); and SB245 recommended oppose (increases the award in tort actions from \$100k to \$250k and adds a new class for gross negligence with a liability maximum of \$1M).

Upon motion duly made and seconded, and carried unanimously, the TMWA Subcommittee approved staff recommendations on all bills except to change the position on SB207 from watch to oppose, to oppose SB 217, and to watch SB 221 and SB 245.
