## THE DOG DAYS OF SUMMER ARE OVER TIME TO COOL DOWN YOUR WATERING

As we start moving through October, the temperatures will cool down more consistently. When this happens, our plants, trees and grasses start to transition. To help this natural process of dormancy, your watering schedule should cool down as well.

Begin by reducing run times or dropping a day off your weekly watering schedule. Then, as chilly mornings turn into colder days, you can slow down watering to once a week or less. When grasses grow more slowly, it means your yard is moving toward dormancy. At this phase, less water near your root systems is better than too much!

Your grass is dormant when it stops growing altogether, brought on by cool temperatures. This is when your sprinkler system can be shut off for the winter. And don't forget to drain


