Dan Nubel, TMWA Staff Attorney, provided an update on the status of bills, in particular AB104 (omnibus bill) which has passed out of committee with amendments and has a fiscal note from Nevada Department of Water Resources (DWR), but on track to move onto the Senate.

Stefanie Morris, TMWA Outside Counsel, reported on the status of AB419 (requiring the State Engineer to adopt regulations regarding the review process for certain applications). Ms. Morris informed the Subcommittee that it has been scheduled for a hearing on April 9th and staff have prepared a letter to submit in advance.

At this time, the Subcommittee discussed the intent of AB419 and approved staff direction in submitting letters ahead of the hearing.

No action was taken.

6. <u>PRESENTATION OF STATUS REPORT ON LEGISLATION OF INTEREST TO WRWC AND</u> <u>POSSIBLE DIRECTION REGARDING WRWC'S POSITION. THIS ITEM MAY BE</u> <u>COMBINED WITH ITEM 5.</u>

Lucas Foletta, WRWC General Counsel provided an update on SB286 (tribal cooperation and engagement), which passed out of committee without any amendments, and will head to the Senate.
