TRUCKEE MEADOWS COMMUNITY FORESTRY COALITION WINTER TREE WATERING



Winter watering is important to our region's community forest. As temperatures cool, reduce outdoor watering, but remember that fall and winter in the Truckee Meadows are often characterized by dry air, dry soil and significant temperature swings—all of which can stress your trees.

The need for winter watering may not be obvious, but trees and plants need water during dry spells. To help keep your trees healthy, follow these winter watering tips:

- Water your trees every two to four weeks if there is no significant precipitation. A healthy, sufficiently-watered tree can withstand strong winds and freezing temperatures far better than one that is dry and stressed.
- Water when temperatures are above 40 degrees, and early enough in the day that the water will not freeze overnight. Be sure to disconnect and drain your hoses once you're done watering.
- Avoid spraying trunks, as it increases the risk of frost injuries.

- **Information on your water use**
- **Update your account information**
- **Enter a service request**

You can also access your account information anytime with TMWA's automated telephone line. It's easy and convenient – just call us at **(775) 834-8080, option 2** and have your eight-digit TMWA account number ready.

CONCERNED ABOUT PAYING YOUR BILL? CALL TODAY TO MAKE PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS.

If you are concerned about paying your water bill on time and in full, please do not wait for the past due date and run the risk of having your water shut off. Simply call us at **(775) 834-8080, option 2**,



and our customer service staff will review your account. Most customers are eligible to make payment arrangements if they are unable to pay their bill in full by the due date. By calling TMWA before missing a payment, we may be able to help you avoid additional charges and/or interruption in service.
