

**DRAFT MINUTES OF THE March 6, 2015
CONCURRENT MEETING OF THE LEGISLATIVE SUBCOMMITTEES OF
THE TRUCKEE MEADOWS WATER AUTHORITY AND
THE WESTERN REGIONAL WATER COMMISSION**

The concurrent meeting of the Legislative Subcommittees of the Truckee Meadows Water Authority (TMWA) and the Western Regional Water Commission (WRWC) met at TMWA, 1355 Capital Blvd., Reno, Nevada in the Independence Conference Room. Mike Pagni and Steve Walker provided a brief description of each bill TMWA is monitoring as well as their insights into what was happening at the legislature on each bill and gave staff's recommendation. Mr. Rhodes reviewed several of the bills listed, and stated that the staff recommendation on all BDR's is *watch*, except for BDR 486 which is to *support*, and *neutral/watch* on the bills that have been introduced.

Upon motion made and seconded, and carried by unanimous vote of the members, the WRWC Subcommittee approved staff's recommendations on all BDR's and bills.
