Truckee River Etiquette

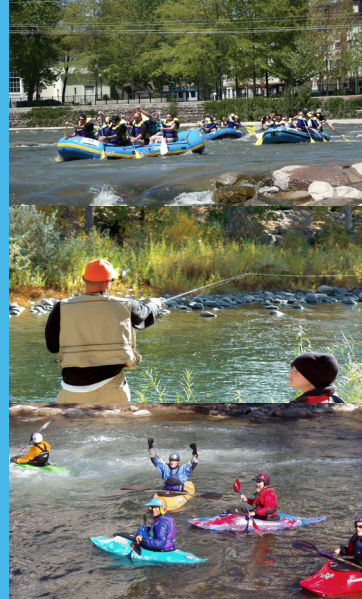
Be polite to everyone and remember everyone has the right to be there.

- * When using an authorized access, be organized before you approach the area. Have your raft or kayak ready and everything in it.
- * Wear a life vest and helmet.
- * People going downstream have the right-of-way.
- * Take turns in the whitewater park holes.
- * Give an angler a wide berth and try to avoid floating over the anglers fishing hole. If you must come close, try to refrain from disturbing the area being fished.
- * Don't tie up to a tree, rock or bridge to surf in the whitewater park.
- * Anglers should avoid fishing near launching areas.

- * Don't encroach on another angler's space.
- * Try not to monopolise a good fishing spot. Fish awhile and move on to another location on the river.
- * No diving allowed in the whitewater park.
- * Always have dogs on a leash.
- * Keep noise to a minimum.
- * Respect private property and don't trespass.
- * Use public toilets.
- * Don't litter.
- * Children must be under adult supervision.
- * No glass or alcohol allowed in the whitewater park.
