

Obey speed limit in school zones.

With the end of summer vacation for many Washoe County students, Reno Police Officers remind us to follow the speed limit of 15-miles-per-hour in a school zone.

Many children go to year-round schools where the school speed limit is heavily enforced by the Reno Police Department.

Officers in the traffic division are out in full force at schools during September to monitor traffic and write tickets.

The fine for speeding in a school zone can range from \$200 to \$800 depending on how fast you are going.

It is important to watch for children walking in crosswalks and riding their bikes on the streets and along bike paths to and from their schools.

Police also remind drivers to stop for school buses when children are getting on and off the bus.
